






Workshop Objectives

Session Guidelines



Oral Presentations

- Presenters are given a <u>20-minute</u> presentation slot, including time for questions and answers.
- Speakers will be given a <u>3-minute warning</u> before the end of their allotted time.
- Presenters should be in their session room 15 minutes before the session begins at the latest, and identify themselves to the session chairs;
- Presentations shall be uploaded using the computer in the Speaker Ready area (Registration hall), they can be uploaded at any time from the start of the
 meeting but no later than 30 mins before session starts.
- All presentations must be run from the presentation computer, in .ppt or .pdf format;
- Technical support is available in the presentation rooms to start your presentation for you.
- The presentations will be <u>streamed live online</u>, and they will be accessible later via the <u>ESA EO Open Science</u> YouTube-channel.

Poster Presentations

- One free poster session, split on Tuesday & Thursday afternoons at the exhibition hall from 16:30 to 19:00;
- You can hang your poster when you arrive and leave it up for the duration of the workshop.

Instructions to Chairpersons

- Each session will be run by the 2 co-chairs, who shall introduce the speakers and strictly enforce the session schedule.
- > Speakers shall be given a <u>3-minute warning</u> before the end of their allotted time.
- > The Round Table Discussion shall be run by all the Chairs together.
- Based on the Session and Round Table Discussion, the Chairs shall prepare together a Session Summary & Recommendations, which will be presented by one of them at the Friday's Session Summaries from 11:30 to 13:30 in the Auditorium I.


Standard Menu
